1. SELFISHNESS

2. BITTERNESS

3. REJECTION

THREE STEPS TO TRANSFORMING THE HEART

1. INVITE THE HOLY SPIRIT TO SHOW ME

2. INVITE THE HOLY SPIRIT TO CHANGE ME

"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me."

PSALM 51:10-11 NIV

3. INVITE THE HOLY SPIRIT TO FILL ME

"Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit."

EPHESIANS 5:18 NIV
